Dear Parent/Carer

As you will be aware, the DfE guidance for Relationships and Health Education became statutory from September 2020. The guidance requires us to consult with different groups in our community when developing our policies in this area. Many of you have already supported us by completing the online survey (we sent out just before half-term) seeking your views on this, for which we thank you.

As part of our consultation, we would next like to survey all children in Years Five and Six to find out their views about when they feel various aspects of relationships and health education should be taught. We will also ask them who they would prefer to learn this information from. The children in Year Six be asked an additional question, based around their experience of learning about puberty this term, specifically whether they feel the teaching met all their learning needs. We will use the information gathered from the survey to inform our next steps in finalising the policy, but all information will remain anonymous.

If you would like more information, please do not hesitate to get in touch, otherwise we will assume that you are happy for your child to take part in this survey before Christmas.
