### **Year Three Educational Visits and Trips 2021 - 22**

Trips and visits are back!

We are writing to provide you with details and approximate costs of the events that will be taking place this academic year. We hope that this will give you an overall view of the dates and prices involved, enabling you to budget accordingly.

This is our best guess at what will be coming up in the year ahead but there may be other visits arranged as the year progresses, for example sports competitions. We will give you as much notice of these as possible.

**Families in receipt of free school meals will not be required to pay for these activities, with the exception of residential visits, as the school will continue to fund events for these families.**

We cannot allow any student to take part in an activity unless any risk involved is assessed as being low. Details of the trips and our expectations will be conveyed to students via assemblies and during class time.*

#### Provisional Trips/Events

##### **Autumn Term:**

Wood Green – a visit to school from the animal shelter – no cost

Toothpaste Day – in-school activity- no cost

Nativity Performance – information will be sent at the beginning of December

##### **Spring Term:**

Swimming lessons for two classes at One Leisure St Neots – approximate cost £26.50

Fitzwilliam and Zoology Museum Trip – will be cost of transport and admin only – approximate cost £8.00

Egyptian Day – approximate cost £3.00 if led by an external agency.

History / Design and Technology Workshop – approximate cost £4.00

##### **Summer Term:**

Swimming lessons continue for other classes – approximate cost £26.50

Burwell House Residential Visit – approximate cost £150.00

Greek Day – approximate cost £3.00 if led by an external visitor.

Sun Day – in-school activity linked to science topic – no cost
