Dear Parent/Carer

Your child's class (**3CD**) will be taking part in eight swimming sessions starting on **25th February**. They will attend swimming according to the following schedule:

1. **Friday 25th February**
2. **Friday 4th March**
3. **Friday 11th March**
4. **Friday 18th March**
5. **Friday 25th March**
6. **Friday 1st April**

No swimming on 25th April

*They will then change to a **Monday** as follows:*

7. **Monday 9th May**
8. **Monday 16th May**

The aim of these sessions is to help children to achieve the expected standard at the end of Key Stage Two – to swim unaided for a sustained period of time over a distance of 25m. Children who can swim more than 25m will be given more advanced tuition.

Venue: St Neots Swimming Pool
Time: Afternoons
Equipment needed: Swimming trunks for boys/one piece costume for girls, towel and cap if possible.

Earrings will need to be removed before swimming by the children themselves.

To cover the cost of transport we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £18.50. Payment can be made on ParentMail or by cash or cheques. Cheques should be made out to 'Crosshall Junior School'. Families in receipt of free school meals do not need to pay.

The children will be going in two groups, at 1.30pm and 2.10pm, returning at 2.50pm and 3.30pm. **This second group will therefore be late returning to school.** Your child will be in the **first** group from 25th February until 18th March and will be back on time for regular pick up. Your child will be in the **second** group from 25th March until 16th May and therefore returning late.
