YEAR FIVE RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO YORK Monday 20th to Thursday 23rd February 2023

We are very excited to be able to offer a residential trip to York and the surrounding area for our Year Five students. They will be staying at the superbly equipped YHA York, situated in a leafy suburb close to the centre of the city.

The total cost of this trip will be approximately £250.00. This price includes:

- all food, accommodation and coach travel;
- fees for activities such as the Jorvik Group (Viking Centre, DIG), guided tours around the local area (e.g. York Minster) and visits to several of the local attractions;
- a range of fun evening activities and workshops.

ACCOMMODATION

Our accommodation will be in a series of rooms in secure wings reserved for the exclusive use of Crosshall Junior School. Our staff members will be situated in the same areas as the children. The stay is full board and the hostel's kitchen can cater for any medical dietary requirements.

If your child decides that he/she does NOT want to attend the residential visit, we will expect them to come to school as usual that week.

COSTING & PAYMENT SCHEDULE

If you would like your child to take up a place on this very exciting trip, please make payment of a <u>non-refundable</u> deposit of £85.00 to secure his/her place either on +Pay via <u>www.parentmail.co.uk</u> or with the form below. Payments should be made by <u>Friday 7th October 2022</u>. Please also return the form below if you do not wish your child to take a place on this trip.

The final balance of approximately £165.00 will be due by Wednesday 14th December 2022.

Once the deposit has been received, further payments can be made in instalments. If you wish to do so, please request a Savings Card from the School Office when you send in your first payment.

INFORMATION EVENING

There will be the opportunity to find out more about this trip and ask any questions during an information event on Tuesday 20th September. Further details about this event will be sent out closer to the time.

Should we have any concerns about your child's behaviour, we will contact you to discuss their place on trips. We reserve the right to not take any student whose behaviour is considered in any way antisocial or unsafe. The Academy is required to undertake a risk assessment for all trips and visits. We cannot allow any student to take part in an activity unless any risk involved is assessed as being low. Details of the trips and our expectations will be conveyed to students via assemblies and during class time.
