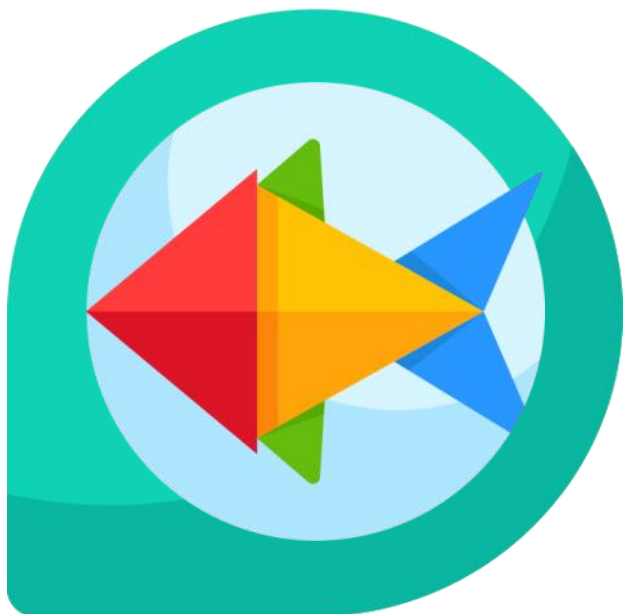

PAPER CRAFT CLUB

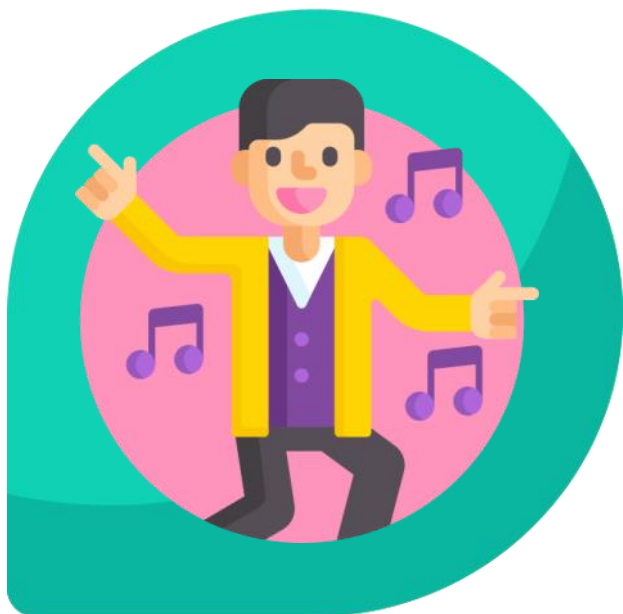


Do you enjoy making things with paper?

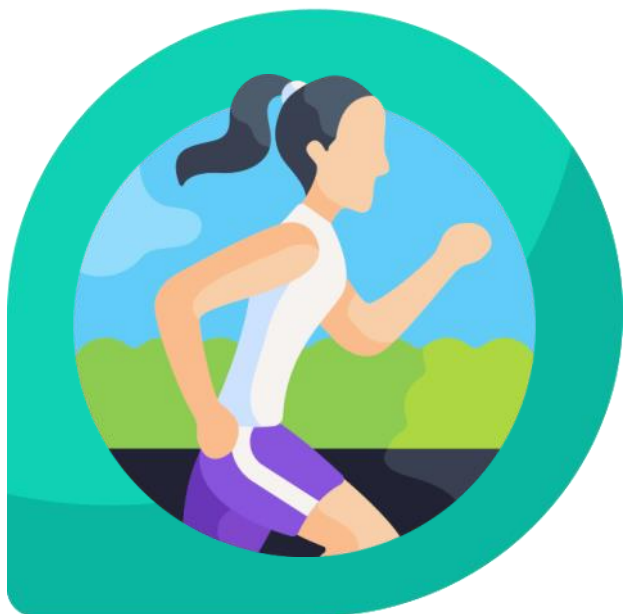


Open to Year Five and Six!
