### **Chiltern Open Air Museum**

**4CH & 4NT:** Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November

This term, Year Four will be learning about prehistory. This begins with learning all about the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. It is a very interesting topic and we have managed to really enhance and add some sparkle to the topic by securing a visit to the Chiltern Open Air Museum.

The children will leave school at 8:45 and return for 15.20 for the normal school home time. Please remind your child about safety whilst on the coach.

### **Workshops and Clothing**

There are two workshops throughout the day: Stone Age and Iron Age. The Stone Age workshop takes place outside, so warm clothing is essential.

Children will need to wear long trousers, a long sleeve top, old trainers/walking boots or wellies, and they **must wear a school top**. Due to the nature of some of the activities, items may become muddy and/or wet. They will also need a coat, snack and water bottle.

#### The Stone Age workshop includes:

- re-enacting a hunt;
- holding and inspecting replica artefacts;
- practising the skills necessary to start a fire;
- making pigment drawings. (These come home with us!)

#### The Iron Age workshop - in an Iron Age Roundhouse

- grinding grain to create flatbreads;
- making butter from cream;
- creating fashion clay pottery.

The children will also look at the growth of crops and evidence of Iron Age jewellery.

**Costs:** We would appreciate a voluntary contribution of **£26.00** per child to cover transport and admission costs. Please indicate on the attached reply slip whether you are able to make this contribution.
