Visit to Verulamium (St Albans) – Wednesday 22nd March – 4AA & 4NT
Friday 24th March – 4CH & 4KW

To add to the children's experience of Roman life in Britain, we are visiting a fantastic museum in St Albans (the Roman city of Verulamium). We will also be visiting the Hypocaust and the Roman Theatre. The Verulamium Museum houses a stunning collection of Roman artefacts, and the children will see objects created and used thousands of years ago. Part of the visit will be led by a museum expert. It is an exciting opportunity for the children to have a more realistic understanding of what life was like all those years ago.

Arrangements are as follows:

- Dates:** Wednesday 22nd March (4AA & 4NT) and Friday 24th March (4CH & 4KW)
- Depart Crosshall:** 8:45am. Children should be brought to school at 8:20am and dropped off at the usual Year Four exits, not the blue doors.
- Back to Crosshall:** Approx 3:15pm
- Lunch arrangements:** Packed lunches will be provided for all children, who normally have a school meal. Children, who usually bring a packed lunch, should do so on the day of the trip. Please note that packed lunches must not contain nuts or nut products.
- Suitable clothing:** Please ensure all children wear school uniform, have a coat and water bottle.
- Costs:** We would appreciate a voluntary contribution of **£22.00** per child to cover transport and admission costs. Children in receipt of free school meals are not required to pay.
Should insufficient funds be raised, the school reserves the right to cancel this trip and any monies received will be returned.
