**YEAR SIX: MOCK END OF KEY STAGE TWO TESTS WEEK AND INFORMATION ABOUT TESTS/ASSESSMENTS**

During the week commencing Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023, the children will have their Mock End of Key Stage Two Test Week. The tests will be on **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> & Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February**, and **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> & Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March**.

It will be an opportunity for the children to experience test conditions before the 'real thing' in May. It will also enable the staff to identify those areas of the curriculum which children still need to focus on, as well as providing us the opportunity to identify how we can best support your child with better test techniques.

**Further Support**

The end of Key Stage Two tests is one method for assessing learning. They are an important part of your child's education and should be taken seriously. However, there is much more to your child's education than testing and the school is aware of that.

Although some children love tests; others can feel worried and anxious. If your child needs a little bit of reassurance/ understanding during test week, or is having worries leading up to the test, please make their class teacher aware via the school office. As a school, we want to make sure your child is prepared and feeling confident about the tests.
