## Clothing

We will be outside most of the day, and the weather may be warm, so please provide your child with a hat, sun cream and plenty of water.

Please send a small snack for your child to have in the morning. **No nuts or nut products** are allowed onto school premises or on any school trips.

## Lunch arrangements

As this trip is taking place on a Monday, please can ALL children, apart from those in receipt of free school meals, bring their own packed lunch.

The cost of the trip is £19.00. As you have already paid the £8.00 deposit, please could payment of the final balance of £11.00 be made by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March. If you have not paid the deposit, then the total amount of £19.00 will be due.

Should insufficient funds be raised, the school reserves the right to cancel this trip and any monies received will be returned.
