YEAR FIVE – Viking Day 30th June

As part our history topic all about the Vikings, we have arrange a very special 'Viking Day' in Year Five on Friday 30th June. We will have a visit from the company Gripping History, who will help to run a wide range of activities to expand and deepen the children's knowledge of the Vikings and their historical skills.

Year Five will learn all about who the Vikings were, where they came from, and what they looked like. They will explore the various trades and skills the Vikings had, the bartering system, runes and rune stones, and how archaeologists uncover and interpret artefacts. They will also learn about Viking weaponry, including archery, and have a go at some drills.
