Children are not to bring sun cream into school or apply it themselves at school due to risk of allergies amongst other children.



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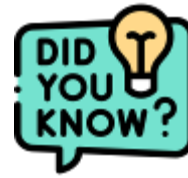

Everyone can do their bit! Thank for your support and cooperation.

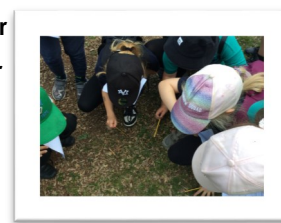
