# **Explanation:**

## **Times Tables**

We use a fun website called Times Tables Rock Stars to help you learn your times tables. We know you have been busy learning your 2, 5 and 10 times tables in Year Two. Using the login details we have given you, login to the website and explore the different games. You will need to design your avatar first and give yourself a cool rock band name!

**Adults:** we have created a Times Tables Rock Stars guide to show you how to login - click <u>HERE</u>; it also explains all the different game options. By the end of Year Two, children need to know their 2, 5 and 10 times tables and related division facts. They will need to know their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables and related division facts by the end of Year Three.

# **Number Bonds Knowledge**

- Know your number bonds to 10 and 20 e.g. 2+8 = 10, 15+5 = 20.
- Know your number bonds to 100 (in multiples of 10) e.g. 10 + 90.
- Know your number bonds to 100 e.g. 12 + 88 = 100, 53 + 47 = 100.

### Task: Spellings

# **Explanation:**

In Year Two you learnt some Common Exception Words. You need to spend some time going over these words and then start looking at the Lower School Word List ready for the Junior School. You don't need to know how to spell all of these words now, but you will need to know them by the end of Year Four. During your first few weeks in Year Three we will test you on the Lower School Word List to help us support you further with your spellings during Year Three.

**Adults:** a spelling strategies guide with some different activities has been created to support you. We have also included some flashcards which you could print and cut out to use over the holidays; alternatively you could make your own flashcards with your child.
