WHOLE SCHOOL SPORTS DAYS

We are delighted to inform you that **on Thursday 20th July 2023** the whole school will be taking part in our annual Sports Day.

The day will comprise a **morning of individual athletics events** that selected children will take part in (your child will receive a letter from their class teacher by Thursday 6th July), and an **afternoon of sports challenges that children will undertake in their House groups** (earning points for their House as they compete in the activities).

The morning session will run from 9:00am until approximately 10:30am.

The afternoon session will run from 1:30pm until approximately 3:10pm. If the weather is hot this session will be shorter.

Each class belongs to a House Team, which has a team colour as illustrated below:

On Sports Day, your child should dress in his/her P.E. kit and arrive at school for the day wearing a coloured, short sleeve T-shirt in the House colour. Sun cream should be applied before arrival and a hat will be needed if the weather is warm. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school and his/ her asthma inhaler (if required).

We welcome family and friends to come and watch, though due to the large numbers of people on the field we ask for a maximum of two spectators per child, and request that you try not to bring prams and pushchairs to the event. Parents and spectators will be able to watch the events from a designated area in order to keep everyone safe.
