Dear Parent/ Carer,

This week saw the release, to schools, of the end of key stage two test results. For our Year Six cohort, it is the culmination of four years' work at our school and for these children, every one of those four years, except the present one, has been touched by the pandemic.

We are very proud of all the children and of the results.

According to the TES, the reading paper required them to read 2,016 words across three texts which was a 34% increase from the previous test. Children had just 34 seconds to answer each of the 38 questions in the booklet.

The exams were challenging, and our children remained confident and calm throughout.

The parents, the children, and the staff have worked together brilliantly throughout their junior years:

- from delivering lunches to homes, to Maya art, mask making;
- from the online Talent Show, to last year's first Sports Day;
- from the Year Three Nativity to the performance of their Leavers' Song.

We know the cohort is secondary ready: open to opportunity, ambitious, resilient, and kind.


