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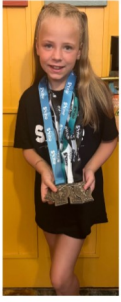
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STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

CAMBRIDGE GIRAFFES - BREAK CHARITY & CAMBRIDGE CITY CENTRE

We are excited to announce that we will be participating in the charity, Break - which supports young people in care, leaving care, and on the edge of care across East Anglia - as they install a large herd of giraffe sculptures around Cambridge city centre in 2024.

Cambridge Standing Tall will feature around 40 of the long-legged sculptures, each designed by an artist and sponsored by a business, taking to the streets of Cambridge for 10 weeks in March, 2024
