Annual Art Competition – last chance reminder!

In preparation for the **Cambridgeshire Young Artist of the Year Competition** we are holding a school art competition open to every year group – entries must be in by Friday 15th December!

There will be art related prizes for first, second and third place in each Year Group for each category, and first place winners will be entered into the Cambridgeshire Young Artist of the Year Competition.

There are two categories for entries: Observational Drawing & Painting, or Textile Art

The Observational Drawing category, children may draw or paint:

- a landscape scene: any place or view such as mountains, woodland, seascape or city scape;
- an animal: any animal wild or pet;
- a bird;
- a portrait of any person: a family member or famous person (not cartoon)

Children may use:

- pencil;
- coloured pencils;
- pastels;
- paint: watercolour, acrylic, poster paint etc.;
- coloured inks.

The Textile Art category, children may make a textile picture on any subject using:

- wool, embroidery threads, and/or fabric;
- knit, weave, or crochet;
- or by creating a collage or using embroidery or applique, by hand or machine sewing.

All entries must be the child's own work. Maximum size A3.

Closing date for entries: Friday 15th December. Please submit work with entry slip attached.

Good luck, and we look forward to seeing the children's artwork!
